ZONAL MEETING.

CAIRO INTERFACING.

Peter Best, G8CQH has written to RAY-Link with the following information.

CAIRO-8 transceivers will now be available direct from the manufacturer AKD. After full collaboration with the CAIRO Laboratory at Aston University, AKD is launching CAIRO-8 versions of its popular range on amateur-band FM transceivers. These have been designated the 2801, 4801 and 6801; for 2m, 4m and 6m respectively.

It may be of particular interest to RAYNET members to note that AKD is also offering a "retro-fit" service to install the CAIRO-8 "host" interface into existing AKD 2001, AKD4001 or AKD 6001 transceivers if required.
